The school is fully geared up to provide a nurturing and structured environment that promotes academic excellence, physical fitness and character development among the students.



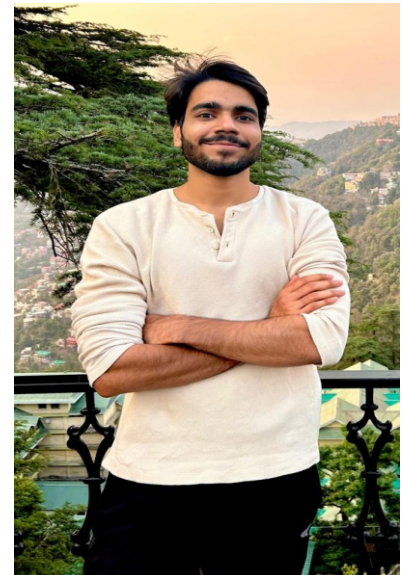


Alumni Corner
